



Gilston Area Neighbourhood Plan

Referendum Information Statement

A referendum relating to the adoption of the Gilston Area Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 27 May 2021.

The question which will be asked in the referendum is:

“Do you want East Hertfordshire District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Gilston Area to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

The referendum area is identified on the map which is included with this information statement.

The referendum area differs to the area which has been designated as the Gilston Area Neighbourhood Plan.

A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if on Tuesday 11 May 2021:

- He or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area; and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the referendum area. A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2,457.11. The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by which that limit has been calculated is 1,612.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.

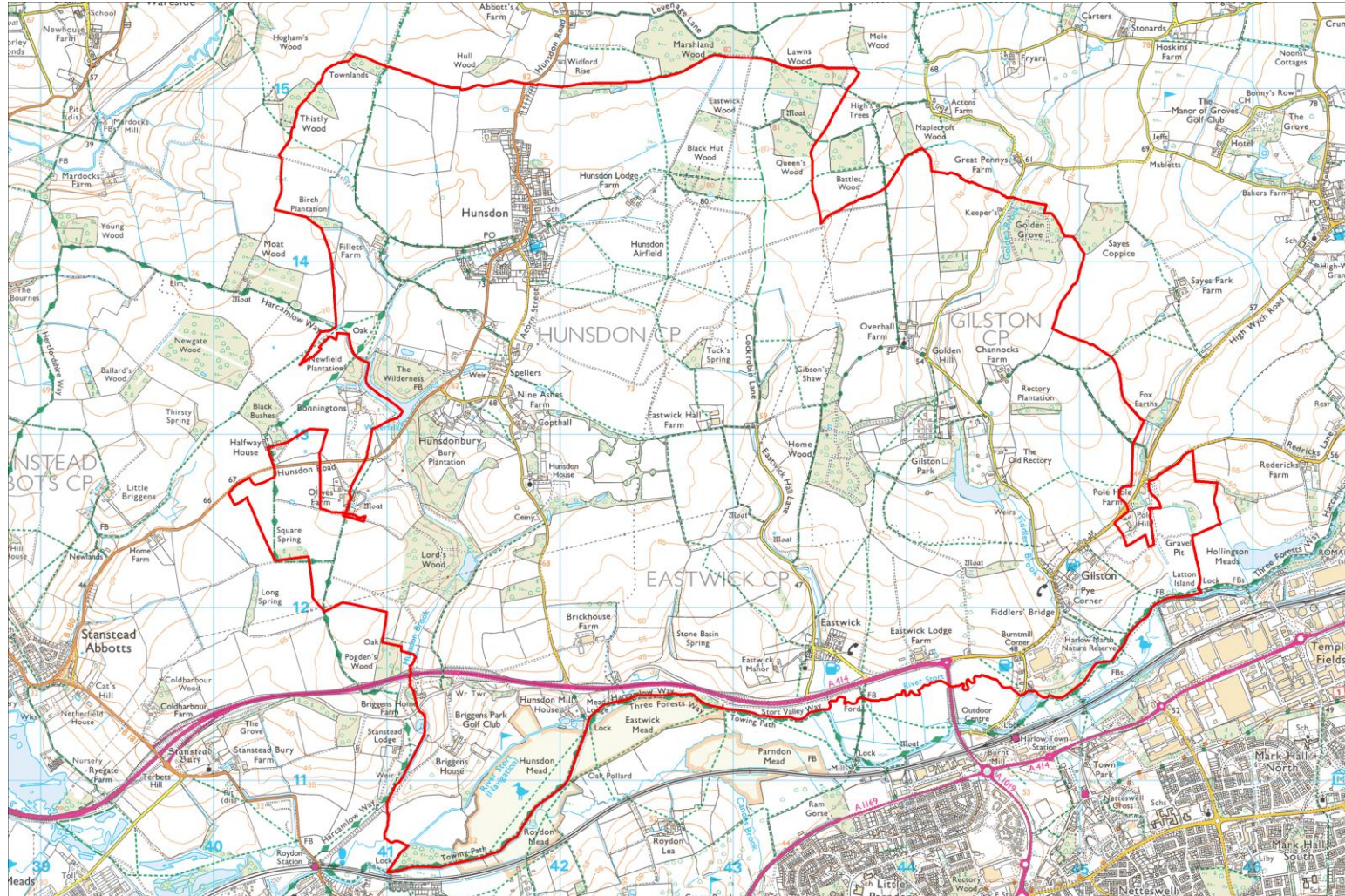
